## Garbage Collection Service Guidelines



### COLLECTION DAYS: MONDAY AND THURSDAY

Please have your trash out by 7A.M. on your service day.

Household garbage, grassclippings, leaves, branches and tree trimmings are collected at the curb. Collection shall be limited to fifteen (15) Bags, Containers or Bundles per collection.

**Important!** For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than forty to fifty pounds (40-50 lbs.) Containers over 45 gallons must have all trash bagged.

Due to safety concerns Waste Management will not service anything over 65 gallons.



### BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Two (2) items on the second collection day of the week

Acceptable items include moving boxes (please break them down and bundle them), old furniture, and appliances.

**Please note!** WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.) without certification that the Freon has been properly removed and recycled, pursuant to current Federal law.



### UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Gasoline  
Vehicle Tires  
Motor Oil (and used filters)  
Batteries

Paint  
Large Pieces of Metal  
Construction Debris (Disposed of by contractor performing work)

# Recycling Collection Service Guidelines



## COLLECTION DAY: MONDAY

Please be sure your recycle container is set out by 7:00 AM on your collection day. Rinse all containers thoroughly to keep recycle container clean.

### RECYCLE OFTEN:



#### Metal Cans

Steel, tin & aluminum soda, vegetable, fruit & tuna cans



#### Plastic Bottles & Containers #1-5 & 7



#### Paper

Brown paper bags, non-confidential office paper, newspaper, magazines



#### Paper Cardboard, Dairy & Juice Containers



#### Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard



#### Glass Bottles & Jars

### RECYCLE RIGHT:

Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled:



#### **DO NOT INCLUDE: Food waste, plastic bags, or polystyrene foam cups & containers**

Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.

Paper food containers must be rinsed out, no caps.

Tissues, paper towels or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.

Make sure food contamination and caps are removed from cans and plastics and all containers are empty.

Separate plastic lids from plastic bottles (often made from different materials)

Keep medical waste (syringes, needles) out of recycling containers or place in safe disposal containers like Waste Management's MedWaste Tracker® box.
